**Fitzgerald Submits Legislation & Appointments to Council for Its Consideration;
Will Present Quarterly Address at March 18 Meeting**

PITTSBURGH – County Executive Rich Fitzgerald submitted three bills to County Council for consideration at its upcoming March 18th meeting:

- Resolution amending the 2008 Capital Budget to reflect \$250,000 in funding secured by the Parks Foundation for the “Settler’s Cabin Park-Panhandle Trail Connector.” The amendment allows for the receipt of the funding, and transfers \$250,000 in matching funds for the project from the 2008 Parks Foundation Project.
- Resolution amending the 2011 Capital Budget to reflect \$1,500,000 in funding secured by the Parks Foundation for the North Park Lake Trail. The amendment allows for the receipt of the funding, and transfers \$3,000,000 (the donation and matching grant funds) into the new north Park Lake Trail Project.
- Resolution amending the Grants and Special Accounts Budget for 2014 to (1) authorize acceptance of funds from the Richard King Mellon Foundation to the Department of Human Services/CYF in the amount of \$41,000 to cover expenses related to the implementation of the Crossover Youth Practice Model which assists in reducing the number of children in out-of-home placement.

Additionally, the Executive submitted three appointments for consideration:

- Thomas Headley, Agricultural Land Preservation Board (reappointment)
- William Sray, Agricultural Land Preservation Board (reappointment)
- Thomas Weaver, Agricultural Land Preservation Board (reappointment)

The County Executive will appear at the Tuesday, March 18, 2014 meeting of Council to present his Quarterly Address.
