County Sports & Athletics Complex at Montour Junction

In February 2009, Allegheny County Executive Dan Onorato held a town hall meeting to discuss the new County Sports & Athletics Complex at Montour Junction. The Sports Legacy Foundation is donating the 78 acres of land in Coraopolis, Moon Twp. and Robinson Twp. to Allegheny County.

The property was formerly owned and operated by the Pittsburgh & Lake Erie Railroad and requires some environmental remediation. Once the environmental work is completed, the former vacant brownfield will be conveyed to the Allegheny County Department of Parks and transformed into a facility that offers nontraditional playing fields, such as rugby, soccer and lacrosse. Plans also include trout fishing access and a mile-long extension of the Montour Trail.
